Objects of Prepositions - not the subjects of sentences.

Singular Nouns with Plural Forms but Singular in meaning - Singular

(News)

Some Nouns ending in (S) - Plural, even though they refer to one thing. (Pliers)

Subjects - different in number and joined by (nor/or) - The one Closer to the verb Determines the number of the verb.

Subjects - Do Not Always begin sentences.

Titles-plural in name - singular
